

## 2<sup>nd</sup> DOSE VACCINE INFO AND 1<sup>st</sup> DOSE CLINIC

- The 2<sup>nd</sup> dose clinic will be held on Friday, April 16, 2021 from 6 a.m. to 11 a.m. This clinic is **ONLY** for citizens who received their first dose of the vaccine at the Convention Center on March 19, 2021. The 1<sup>st</sup> dose will be offered from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. on the same day. A wristband is required for the 1<sup>st</sup> dose clinic.
- This is for the Moderna Vaccine.
- This is a drive-thru clinic.
  1. For those receiving their second dose – same as the first round.
  2. If the citizen was part of the **morning** group from the first round we are asking that they please show up between 6 a.m. and 9 a.m.
  3. If the citizen was part of the **afternoon** group from the first round we are asking that they please show up between 9 a.m. and 10 a.m.
- Overnight parking is not permitted – if you received your first dose at the Convention Center, you are guaranteed to receive your second dose at this clinic.
- For your safety, and that of our volunteers, masks must be worn when the vaccine is given.
- Please have your CDC – COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card handy, this will expedite the vaccine process. If you do not have your card, you will be directed to a specified parking area for assistance.
- There is a maximum of 4 people per vehicle
- Future clinic dates will be announced as soon as they are available.
